### F.I.C.B. Diploma of Honour

At the beginning of 2024, our Board of administration awarded the following F.I.C.B. "Diplomas of Honour": First to two outgoing vicepresidents :

Albino Jorge da SOUSA (PT), Vice President for Portugal of our federation since 2016, organizer in Portugal of two of our international congresses and also producer of the prestigious wines of Quinta da Boeira.

. **David BRAZSIL (HU)** Vice-president of our federation for Hungary since 2018

And to two internationally renowned wine experts

. William STOLLER (U.S.A.), one of Oregon's first wine producers, who contributed to the creation of the International Pinot Noir celebration, which has been held every year in Oregon since 1987 (presented by the Oregon Wine Brotherhood).

. Warren WINIARSKI (U.S.A.), one of the pioneers of viticulture in California's Napa Valley, whose wine won the "Judgment of Paris" in 1976.
